

Opioid Overdose ED Visits by Year: 2015-2024*



Opioid Overdose ED Visits by Month: 2023-2024*




Last 12 Months of ED Visits by Opioid Class: 2023-2024*










ED Visits by Race/Ethnicity








ED Visits by Insurance Coverage
